



Call for offers for services

Youth leadership program

Description:

As a part of the project ***Youth for Change: Building the resilience of Serbian youth through engagement, leadership and development of their cognitive and social-emotional skills***, under STRIVE Global Program, supported by Hedayah International Centre of Excellence for Countering Violent Extremism, and funded by EU, PIN is opening a call for following services:

- Consultancy for youth leadership program
- Development and delivery of youth leadership program

The service contractor(s) for **Consultancy for youth leadership program** is expected to:

- provide framework for youth leadership program (based on the previous experience and state-of-the-art literature);
- ensure quality of the youth leadership program through consultancy in development, delivery, and evaluation of the program;
- provide continuous support to the mentors of youth leaders;
- participate in the meetings and coordinate activities with project staff and expert for development and delivery of youth leadership program.

The service contractor(s) for **Development and delivery of youth leadership program** is expected to:

- develop a training program and training materials
- deliver a 3-day training in Belgrade
- write a comprehensive report about the training

The expected format of the program is a 3-day training (nine 1.5h-sessions) for approximately 25 participants (youth leaders selected from the secondary schools in Belgrade, Sjenica and Novi Pazar). The training is expected to be adjusted to the age and previous experience with this type of engagement of the target group. The topics to be covered include, but are not limited to: (1) Self-expression and communication; (2) Team-building and small group facilitation skills; (3) The power of peer and community-based support; (4) Goal-setting and personal motivation; (5) Social responsibility; (6) Public speaking skills; (7) Organizing and planning skills; (8) Basic leadership theories (e.g. Trait theory) and personal leadership skills; (9) Understanding and countering violent extremism.

The aim of the youth leadership program is to enhance leadership competences of youth to bring change into their local communities by organizing thematic events and promoting positive values and youth engagement.

The youth leadership program is expected to be conducted between 30th of March and 30th of April 2020.

Eligibility:

The call is open to individuals and groups with relevant educational background (i.e. social sciences, psychology, education, etc.), experience (informal education, working with youth, youth leadership programs etc.) and subject matter expertise (topics listed in the description the program). PIN is an equal opportunity employer; thus, no advantage or disadvantage will be given based on age, gender, race, religion, disability, etc.

The offer must include:

- the service(s) to be provided (A – consultancy for youth leadership program or B – development and delivery of youth leadership program)
- short narrative description of the key competences and motivation to participate in the project (up to 500 words)
- CV highlighting the experience relevant for this project
- The financial offer in a form of total cost (inclusive of all taxes and expenses) in EUR

The offer may include supporting documents that speak to the competences and relevant experience of the service provider (letter of recommendation, project reports, etc.).

Selection criteria:

- Relevant previous experience and motivation
- Price
