The Association for Regional Development and Mental Health (EPAPSY) is a NGO providing community mental health and psychosocial support services as a public body in Greece. Established in 1988. Currently it operates community based mental health services in different areas around Greece (22 Residential Facilities, 2 Day Centers, 2 Mobile Mental Health Units in Greek Islands). In 2019 services were provides to 3770 users. The current number of staff is 275

Implementing partner of UNHCR, member of European Network for Training and Research in Mental Health ENTER, European Alliance Against Depression, Network of European Art Festivals for mental Health Enhancement.

Current Funded projects by UNHCR about refugees/asylum seekers:

- Refugee Mental Health Teams (ROMHTs) project: 2 mobile teams of MHPSS professionals in the urban settings of Attica and Thessaloniki provide repond to refugee/asylum seekers mental health needs, who are beneficiaries of Accommodation project ESTIA I.
- Community Psychosocial Workforce (CPW) project: 15 trained refugees provide psychosocial support to other refugees/asylum seekers in the urban settings of Attica.
- Psychosocial Support Helpline project: During the COVID-19 pandemic crisis a Psychosocial support helpline were developed in order to provide immediate psychosocial help and access to services. The helpline is operated by Community Psychosocial Workers (CPWs) (trained refugees/asylum-seekers) and is available from Monday to Friday from 11 a.m. to 7p.m. in Arabic and Farsi.
